

# Adopting Cats at the Nova Scotia SPCA

We are now able to complete your application same day. When you are ready to adopt please stop into the shelter to visit the adoptable cats. You will be required to show photo id.

Cats must leave in a carrier; we typically have some suitable cardboard cat carriers available for purchase from the shelter.

We will also ask that you agree that you will not declaw any cat you adopt from us. For information on alternatives to declawing please visit our website here:

If you are interested in adopting a declawed cat please contact the shelter and we can notify you when an already declawed cats becomes available for adoption.

Please make sure you are ready to take on the commitment of adopting a cat and stop into the shelter or one of our offsite adoption partners when you are ready to make the lifelong commitment to a companion.

If after adopting, you find that your new pet is not the best fit for you, we do provide 2 weeks in which you can return the pet for a full refund of the adoption fee. We recognize that sometimes resident animals already in the home may not be accepting of the new pet, and some things may become apparent only after adoption (such as allergies).
