



Dog Adopters

- Please do not bring anything into the shelter except your ID and payment.
- Remember that appointments are at a set time so please be on time. We need adopters to stay within these time limits in order to properly disinfect between appointments for staff and public safety.
- Upon arrival at our shelter, please adhere to staff instruction and pay close attention to our social distancing guidelines at all times.
- Dog appointments are 30-45 minutes in length for your initial visit to meet the dog. Other members of your household can attend this initial appointment as long as social distancing can be maintained and only those that live in your household attend this appointment with you.
- If, after meeting the dog you've decided to proceed with the adoption, we will finalize the dog adoption paperwork at the end of your visit. Please bring a leash with you to your appointment if you will be ready to proceed and do not have any other dogs at home.
- If you have a dog at home, a second appointment is required to do a meet-and-greet between the dogs to ensure compatibility. The second appointment will be scheduled for 45 minutes and will include time to finalize the adoption paperwork should everything go well. You can book this appointment after completing your initial person visit.
- If you decide you do want to proceed with the adoption please indicate to the SPCA representative your intention to proceed. If you have a dog in your vehicle, one will need to be crated, or separate vehicles would be needed to transport your new dog home. If that is not possible a separate appointment will be set up to complete the adoption of your new dog.
- Preferred method of payment is Mastercard/Visa/Debit. We will also accept cash but it must be the exact amount of the adoption fee.
- During poor weather conditions these appointments may need to be rescheduled as the meetings will take place outside.
