The top fundraiser/fundraising team will have the opportunity to name the next litter of kittens or puppies! We'll send you pictures of the kitties or puppies so you can see the cuteness. We do ask that you pick a few names in advance so we have them available for when the kittens or puppies come in. This way, they are not waiting nameless and can quickly be adopted into furever homes!

### **Submitting Donations**

There are a few different ways to submit your funds for SPCA furry friends!

#### **1. Personal Pawty Animal Fundraising Page**

The easiest way is to encourage all of your supporters to donate directly to your personal fundraising page. Each transaction is 100% secure and they will receive their charitable tax receipt immediately through e-mail. Donations will be able to be used right away to help local animals in need and you will be one step closer to reaching your goal!

#### **2. Submit Donations by Mail**

Collect cash and cheques at your Treat Week party. Donations of \$20 or more are eligible for a charitable tax receipt. Enter the information of donors on your Pawty Pledge Form who would like a charitable tax receipt and they will receive it in the mail the following month.
